Q: "Who are Plantables?"

If you haven't heard of us before, don't worry. We won't take offence. (We're still a fairly new company, but our sister company, Roelands Plant Farms, has been growing for farmers across North America for years!)

We produce organically grown fruit and veggie seedlings and ship them across Ontario and Quebec so more families can enjoy the experience of growing and eating fresh food, without the hassle of growing from seeds or buying dud plants from big box stores.

You can choose from 30+ varieties of organic plants, all grown to be as tasty and easy-to-grow as possible. All just \$4.50 a plant. If you'd like to know more about us, head to plantables.ca and have a look around.

Q: "Why did you start this fundraising program?"

Plantables was started by Adrian and Jodi, a husband-and-wife duo behind Plantables and mom and dad to Mia, Arie, Eva, Theo and Ila.

They knew firsthand that raising money can be a bit of a chore, especially when you've got a long list of other things to do. So, they put together our fundraising program to be the kind they'd always wanted to be involved with: one that is easy-to-set-up, super-simple to run and, best of all, centred around super-healthy products, rather than unhealthy, sugary treats!

Q: "Is there a cap on how much we can raise?"

We don't cap the amount you can earn at all! The more your code is used, the more you earn!

Q: Is there a minimum amount we have to raise?

We will issue cheques for as little as \$25.00. Any earnings below \$25.00 will stay on your account for the next year.

Q: "Do I have to go pick up my plants or deliver them?"

Not at all.

We'll send every plant directly to the door of everybody who orders. All you have to do is share the coupon code (and perhaps send out a few reminders). We'll take care of everything else.

Like we said, you really can do this from your sofa.

Q: "How long can we run the fundraiser for?"

Here's the beauty of our fundraising program: you can run it year after year. The peak time to start promoting is between February - June. (You can even run it alongside other fundraisers. We don't get jealous.)

Q: "What types of plants can I order?"

Every single plant we grow is included in the fundraiser program. That means that whether you've got friends who love their super green smoothies, family members who eat lots of vegetables or colleagues who love their herbal tea, there's bound to be plants for them on our site.

Q: "How do we collect the money?"

Going door-to-door, collecting money and counting it all up are easily the worst parts of fundraising, right? So, we thought we'd do away with all of that.

With our program, you don't need to handle any money at all. Everyone who places an order on the site pays for their own order at the checkout, so there's absolutely no money exchanged. After that, we send you a cheque for 10% of everything you raise during your fundraising efforts.

Q: "What if grandparents want to order but aren't great at using the internet?"

If you have elderly relatives who struggle with the internet, we recommend ordering plants on their behalf and getting them to pay you back. (Although our website is super friendly and easy to use, so they might not even need your help!)

Q: "Where are the plants grown?"

Your plants are all grown and loved at our state-of-the-art greenhouse in Forest, Ontario.

Roelands Plant Farms, our sister company, also use our greenhouse to grow the fruits and veggies for farmers and growers all across North America. (In fact, probably the ones you buy from your local supermarket.)

Q: "Can we have our plants delivered immediately?"

Our shipping season starts in April and ends the last week of June. Each customer can choose which week they prefer to receive their plants. We start accepting orders mid-November for those eager green-thumbs!

Q: "I've got a question that wasn't answered here."
