How EO works!



Admission to EO

You're at the top of the waitlist! CLGW will contact you to set-up an initial meeting, to get to know you and to better understand what we offer.



Intake Phase

We'll meet a few more times to get to know your employment goals and start making a plan for what support you need.



Job Readiness Phase

Together, we work to create a resume and cover letter, build skills and confidence, and offer workshops to get job ready.



Job Seeking Phase

Together, we explore jobs you're interested in and apply.



Active Job Coaching Phase

For up to 13 weeks, we will provide 1:1 support to help you learn your job and its expectations. We'll also build job tools for continued success.



Job Coach Retention Phase

We'll keep in regular contact while you work at your job independently, to make sure you're succeeding. If there is a concern, we may return to providing 1:1 support.

You've made it! You're confident in your skills and working your job on your own. You can reach out if any new employment support needs arise.

EmployMENT Options is a supportive employment service for adults with a developmental disability, offered by Community Living Guelph Wellington.
