GW network explained by Amy, Cora & Annie - An "Emerging Grant" (up to 4.5k, due June 30) through the Ontario Caregiver Assoc - If successful, funds need to be spent by March 2024 - The GW Family Network is different from FEC, & not being led by or connected to CLGW - Open to anyone interested in networking (adult focus) Annie discussed three spending initiatives: 1. Host a family picnic, mix/mingle/start sharing resources and build membership base 2. Pay for someone to be behind the scenes to do some of the work (an honorarium) 3. Hold educational events (with speakers)
