How does it work?

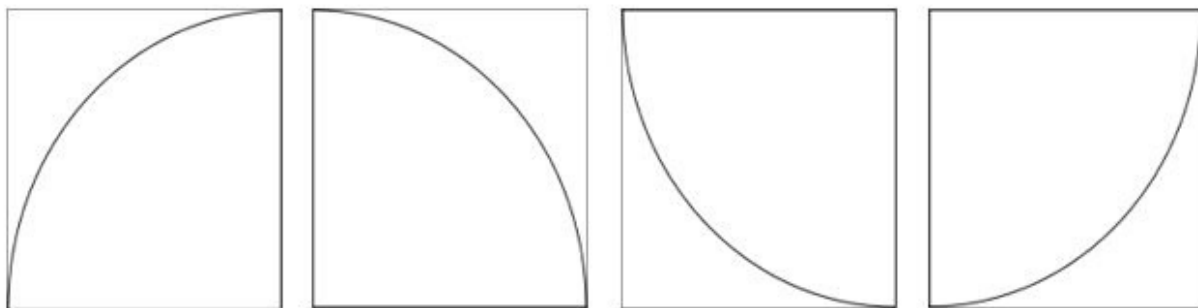
Step #1

“T” with an arrow pointing up = Top

“B” = Bottom
